## CSL THERAPY LAUNCHES MEDICAL EXAMINER CALL TO ACTION CAMPAIGN TO ADDRESS HEALTHCARE NEGLIGENCE IN BODY ALTERING AESTHETICS INDUSTRY

[Upland, CA, April 29, 2024] - CSL Therapy Organization, a leading advocate for healthcare standards in the Body Altering Aesthetics industry, announces the launch of its Medical Examiner Call to Action Campaign. The campaign aims to address mounting healthcare negligence and regulatory gaps within the industry by urging citizens to reach out to their local medical examiners and boards of physicians.

The Body Altering Aesthetics industry has witnessed a concerning rise in postoperative complications, including client neglect, false advertising, underqualified practitioners, and insufficient regulation of nonsurgical body contouring procedures. Recognizing the urgent need for action, CSL Therapy is calling upon concerned citizens to join the movement and advocate for change.

"We cannot continue to ignore the pressing issues plaguing the Body Altering Aesthetics industry," says Guadalupe Beckker, spokesperson for CSL Therapy Organization. The template highlights key issues such as client neglect, false advertising, and the need for better regulation and education within the industry.

  - Add your name at the bottom to personalize the signature.
- Compose the Email:**
  - Create a new email and enter the board's email address.
  - Copy and paste the customized template into the body.

As an organization committed to promoting safety and improving healthcare standards for clients, CSL Therapy recognizes that legislative action is fundamental to addressing these issues and safeguarding the public. However, they also recognize the importance of collaboration with medical professionals and regulatory bodies like yours in addressing these concerns effectively.

Aside from discussing the mounting list of problems that have gone ignored by a little over a decade inclusive of [but not limited to] client neglect; false advertising regarding the safety and efficacy of machines; underqualified practitioners administering treatments without proper training or accreditation; Insufficient enforcement of existing regulations, allowing for unethical practices to persist unchecked— a current significant area of concern is the education being promoted and allowed by nonmedical professionals within the industry. There is a belief that the expertise of medical professionals, such as yourselves, is essential in ensuring that appropriate standards are upheld in educational practices within the Body Altering Aesthetics industry.
